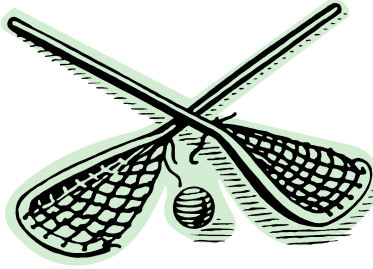


LACROSSE LESSONS OFFERED



Conor Kennedy

Dublin, Ohio resident is offering hourly lacrosse lessons this summer to interested area players. He has played Attack since 4th grade Youth League in Dublin, and has just completed his freshman season as a starter for the University of Kentucky Club Lacrosse team. In the fall of 2008, the Wildcats joined the Southeastern Lacrosse Conference (SELC) and the Men's Collegiate Lacrosse Association (MCLA). The "Cats" compete in the Central Region of Division 1 of the SELC, playing schools like Vanderbilt, Georgia Tech, Georgia, Auburn, Wake Forest and Tennessee. In 11 games this year, Conor totaled 28 points, with 18 goals and 10 assists, ranking him in the top third of all Division 1 Club players.

Conor graduated from Dublin Coffman High School in 2008, where he played both lacrosse and football all four years. As a senior, he was a starter at Attack on the Rocks' Lacrosse team, helping the squad to a 10-8 record while competing against the best teams in Ohio. He finished his high school career in the top ten in all time goals with 41, and total points with 57. He was also a starting defensive tackle on the Rocks' OCC and Regional Champion football team of 2007.
